

GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

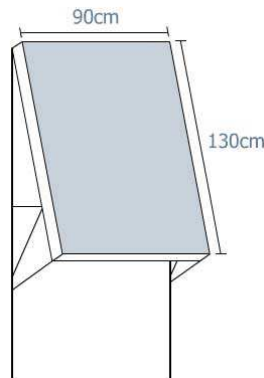
These guidelines have been prepared to give authors some technical advice in preparing poster presentations and to ensure uniformly high-level presentations at the Conference.

1. PREPARATION OF POSTERS

- Posters should be simple, brief and prepared having in mind, primarily, their use as a basis for the presentation and possible discussion of the work with interested persons. A poster should be attractive, with wide use of graphic material (graphs, pictures).
- The poster should include an Abstract. The information may conveniently be divided into sections, starting with an Introduction and ending with Conclusion. Please summarize the main points of your paper, avoiding long sentences.
- As poster should be readable by more than one person at the same time, a letter size of at least 5 mm in height for the text and 10 mm for the section headings are suggested.

2. POSTER BOARD DIMENSIONS

- The available display space is 90 cm wide and 130 cm high. Do not exceed that space.
- Up to nine sheets of the A3 format (30 cm × 42 cm in portrait orientation) can be fit in a display space. Each of the sheets could conveniently contain a complete piece of information, such as the abstract, a figure of table with a simple legend, or a few entire paragraphs. Make wide use of graphs and pictures to make your poster attractive to the audience.
- Any necessary equipment for attaching the sheets to the board will be available near the poster location. Please use only the provided materials in order not to damage the panels and enable a smooth removal afterwards.



3. OTHER REMARKS

- Please find the exact time when your presentation will take place in the Preliminary Program of the Conference.
- An author is expected to be at the poster location during the presentation time assigned for the poster session. This time will be specified in the Preliminary Program of the conference, together with the time assigned for putting up and taking down the posters.
- Please note there will be no session chairpersons for the poster discussions.
